Subject: Final Selection List-cum-Allocation of Cadres & Departments for remaining Class-IV Posts under the provisions of the Jammu & Kashmir Appointment to Class-IV (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2020, advertised vide Notification No. 01 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020-Filling up of six reserved posts thereof.

NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the Final Selection, under Phase-II, for 3422 Class-IV posts in District/Divisional/Union Territory Cadres, advertised vide Notification No. 01 of 2020 dated 04.06.2020, was notified by the Board vide Notification No.SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/6202-09 dated 06.10.2022 and forwarded to the General Administration Department vide letter No. SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/6273-78 dated 18.10.2022; and

Whereas, six (06) posts in the aforesaid selection, from among the posts earmarked to the Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwDBs), sub-category of Low Vision, were kept Reserved, for want of a clarification with regard to the suitability of the candidates figuring against these posts; and

Whereas, the candidates, who were otherwise figuring against these reserved posts, approached the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh in case bearing WP(C) PIL No. 29/2020 titled National Federation of Blind V/S UT of J&K & Ors. The Hon'ble High Court passed the following directions in the matter:

"...Accordingly, we direct the respondents to appoint the aforesaid 6 (six) blind candidates with the observation that their appointment will be provisional and will be subject to outcome of instant the writ petition. Their appointments will, of course, be subject to verification of the relevant documents by the appointing authority..."

Whereas, the matter was taken up with the General Administration Department, which, vide letter No. GAD-MTGORBIV/290/2022 (7071886) dated 08.05.2024, forwarded the opinion of Department of Law, Justice & Parliamentary Affairs and advised the Board to consider the aforesaid candidates as suitable for these Class-IV posts; and

Whereas, the matter was examined in light of the advice of General Administration Department/opinion of Department of Law Justice Parliamentary Affairs and placed in the Board for consideration. The Board, in its 272nd meeting held on 27.05.2024, decided to fill the six posts, which have been kept reserved for these Blind candidates in the Final Selection List notified for the Class-IV posts, advertised vide Notification No. 02 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020.

Now therefore, after taking into consideration all the aforementioned factors and in compliance to the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh in case WP(C) PIL No. 29/2020 titled National Federation of Blind V/s UT of J&K & Others, the six posts, reserved in the Final Selection List notified by the Board for the Class-IV posts under Phase-II and forwarded to the General Administration Department vide letter No. SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/6273-78 dated 18.10.2022, are hereby filled by considering the candidature of the Persons with Benchmark Disabilities as per **Annexure-A** to this notification. It is further notified that:


(i) The above notification shall be subject to outcome of writ petition(s)/application(s), if any, pending adjudication before any competent court of law.

(ii) This shall also be subject to the outcome of such *enquiry*, involving any candidate(s), as figuring in this List.

(iii) Formal recommendations to the concerned indenting department shall be forwarded separately.

(iv) Once the recommendations are forwarded, the candidates shall have 21 days to submit their verification rolls in triplicate before the appointing authority.

(v) The candidates, whose recommendations are kept withheld, shall furnish the requisite documents within a period of one month from the date of this notification in the Board.
