NOTICE

Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board notified the Final Selection List for the post of Sub Inspector (Police), Home Department vide notification No. JKSSB-Scry/26/2023-03 dated 08.01.2024, wherein you had applied under the Other Social Caste (OSC) category; and

Whereas, the Advertisement notification issued by the Board had following provisions relating to the production/validity of category certificates:

"7(II) A candidate seeking his /her consideration under Reserved Categories must ensure that he/she possess a valid/ Category Certificate as on the Cut Off Date.

15(IV) The candidates who are shortlisted for Document Verification are required to appear for Document Verification along with the original documents as well as self-attested Photostat copy of each document as per the Advertisement Notification. The candidate must be in possession of the prescribed academic qualification and other documents like Domicile certificate, Category certificate on or before the last date of submission of online application form.

d. Caste/Category Certificate, if belongs to reserved categories."

Whereas, the cut-off date for applying for the aforesaid posts was **26.12.2021**, the OSC category Certificate issued in your favour by Tehsildar R.S. Pura on 10.06.2014 had expired on 09.06.2019 and the second and third OSC Certificates issued by Tehsildar Suchetgarh on **09.06.2022** and **21.12.2023**, were issued after the cut-off date notified for these posts. Thus, none of the OSC certificates submitted by you in the Board for consideration of your candidature under the said category were valid on the cut-off date/crucial date for the said posts; and

Whereas, you have also filed an O.A. No. 61/30/2024 titled Reetika Kumari Vs UT of J&K & Ors in the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu Bench and vide its order dated 12.01.2024, the Hon'ble CAT has disposed of the OA with the following directions:




"Accordingly, in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the applicant, the Original Application is disposed at the admission stage, without entering into the merits of the case, with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the pending representation of the applicant dated: 01.01.2024 by passing a reasoned and speaking order in the light of judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court as well as judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Jammu & Kashmir in the case of Saima Ashraf Vs State of Jammu & Kashmir and others annexed with the representation. Before taking any decision, the applicant shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing. The whole exercise shall be undertaken within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Till then, one post under the Other Social Category shall be kept reserved in the final selection list dated: 08.01.2024.

With the above directions, the Original Application stands disposed off."

Accordingly, in view of the factual position stated above and in compliance to the directions of the Hon'ble CAT, Jammu in O.A. No. 61/30/2024, you are hereby afforded an opportunity of being heard to present your case within **Seven (7)** days from the issuance of this Notice, in the J&K Services Selection Board, CPO Chowk Panjtirthi, Jammu/Zam Zam Complex, Rambagh, Srinagar (as per your convenience), before taking a final decision in the matter.
