Subject: O.A No.1013/2022 titled Rakshit Maria V/s UT of J&K and others-Consideration thereof.

Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board advertised various posts of Class-IV in various departments, District, Divisional and UT Cadre of J&K vide Advertisement Notification No. 01 of 2020 dated- 26.06.2020 under the J&K Appointment to Class-IV (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2020, notified vide S.O. 184 of 2020 dated- 04.06.2020; and

Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board after completion of the selection process, issued the Selection List and forwarded the same to the Indenting Department; and

Whereas, the applicant feeling aggrieved of non-selection, filed O.A No. 1013/2022 titled Rakshit Maria v/s UT of J&K and others, seeking following reliefs:

- i. *Directing the respondents to re-determine new Selection List after awarding the additional 05 marks to the applicant as he is the candidate whose family members neither is nor has been in Government Service, including in PSUs/Boards/Autonomous Body etc. substantially owned and controlled by the Government and shall be entitled for additional 05 marks.*
- ii. *Directing the official respondents to give additional 05 marks to the applicant for which the applicant is entitled.*
- iii. *Direction to the official respondents not to appoint the candidates who obtained less marks than the applicant in the written examination.*

Whereas, the Hon'ble Tribunal vide order dated 07.03.2025 allowed the present T.A with the following directions, the operative part of which is reproduced below:

"...Accordingly the OA is allowed. The respondents are directed to re-consider the case of the applicant sympathetically by allotting him additional 05 points extra weightage, if he is otherwise eligible for the post in question. The exercise be completed within two months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs. "

Whereas, the case of the petitioner was examined as per available records and in light of aforesaid directions passed by the Hon'ble Tribunal and it has been found that the

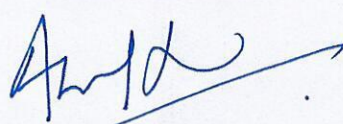


applicant in his application form has not applied under the category of No-Government Employee (NGE) which becomes the basis of him for not being eligible to avail such benefit. Besides, the NGE certificate (Annexure to O.A) has been issued well after the cut-off date; and

Whereas, the selection process for these posts has already been completed and the selection list also stands operated by the Indenting Department for appointment of the eligible/recommended candidates and allowing such consideration at this stage is neither permissible nor possible under rules and if such a course is followed then it is not possible for the Board to complete any selection and is also having the tendency of opening the flood gates for such litigation.

Now therefore, the case of the applicant has been considered in light of directions dated 07.03.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Tribunal and the claim of the applicant found devoid of any merit, hence rejected.
